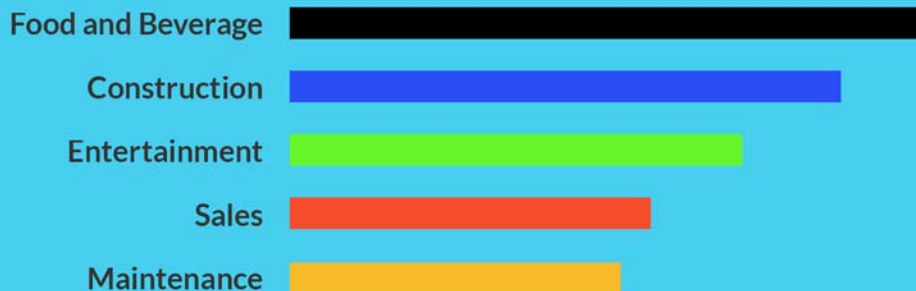
DRUG ABUSE BY INDUSTRY
